

 - ii. Other students taking projects from internet.



Response 1: the student must apply for Re-evaluation as per the university norms.


Response 2: the HoD office is verifying the student's claims. He must submit proof regarding the same. He must also specify in how many project evaluation presentations, he was present.





During the discussions the following points emerged:


1. Centre has begun the process of tie up with the IIT Ropar by filling the Performa sent by them for exchange program.

 - Chess, B., and West, J. (2007). Secure Programming with static Analysis. Addison Wisley Software Security Series.



 - iv. As we are having limited number of faculty and research area, so we can opt Co-guide for our M.Tech students from the college and vice-versa.




During the discussions the following points emerged:
