6. Biochemical and Biophysical Methods/ Advance Techniques in Microbiology will be introduced as elective courses in place of Principles of Ecology, Evolution and Developmental Biology.

Semester IV

7. The course content of the course content of Genetic engineering and Microbial Biotechnology will be modified and Genetic Engineering will be renamed as Advances in Genomics, Transcriptomics and Proteomics.

8. Host Pathogen Interaction and Microbial Diagnostics will be introduced as new elective courses.

9. The DEÇ1 & DECII will be also modified.


