In this proposal, Prof Jain aims at studying and characterizing two newly emerging atypical foci of leishmaniasis, one in India and one in Nepal to understand why *L. donovani* pathology changed from a visceral to a cutaneous disease. She will not only sequence the genomes of the different isolates but also investigate immunological correlates in visceral and cutaneous patients, which is an important aspect of this study. Considering that the spread of new forms of leishmaniases has been reported in other parts of the world and changes in pathology could impact on treatments and resistance, it is an important and timely study. There is a clear need to have more genomic and functional data to understand the emergence and spread of new forms of Leishmaniasis.

The two objectives and the experimental design are clear and well described. The collaboration with the group of Prof. Matlashewski is important in the feasibility of the first objective aimed the molecular characterization of the isolates from India and Nepal. The immune profiling of patients is necessary as it could provide benchmark information and understanding of the correlation between genetic polymorphisms and different pathologies in atypical leishmaniasis. In the long term, such studies could help in the identification of new virulence factors present in Leishmania and in understanding why different Leishmania species give rise to different pathologies. This is still an unsolved question and the only way to answer it is to accumulate data on the genetics of the parasites and on immune correlates. Finally, the last objective (mice studies) could help in defining the parameters useful to understand skin versus visceral dissemination.

The network proposed should be able to provide answers to the raised questions. The project is ambitious and my only concern is its feasibility in the proposed period.

Condition for placing of grant amount:

4. The institute will maintain separate audited account for the project and the amount of grant will be kept in a bank account earning interest. The interest earned should be reported to DST while submitting the (financial year wise) Statement of Expenditure/Utilization Certificate. The interest thus earned will be treated as a credit to the institute to be adjusted towards further instalment of the grant.

Conditions for submission of SE/UC and Progress report:

- 5. This sanction is subject to the condition that :
 - (a) the grantee organisation will furnish to the Department of Science & Technology, financial year wise Utilization Certificate (UC) in the proforma prescribed as per GFR 2017 and audited statement of expenditure (SE) along with up to date progress report at the end of each financial year duly reflecting the interest earned / accrued on the grants received under the project. This is also subject to the condition of submission of the final statement of expenditure, utilization certificate and project completion report within one year from the scheduled date of completion of the project.

(b) While submitting Utilisation Certificate/Statement of Expenditure, the organisation has to ensure submission of supporting documentary evidences with regard to purchase of equipment/capital assets as per the provisions of GFR 2017. - (c) a transparent procurement procedure in line with the Provisions of General Financial Rules 2017 will be followed by the Institute/Organisation under the appropriate rules of the grantee organisation while procuring capital assets sanctioned for the above mentioned project and a certificate to this effect will be submitted by the Grantee organisation immediately on receipt of the grant;

8. DST reserves sole rights on the assets created out of grants. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of government grants (except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned in accordance with the procedure laid down in GFR 2017), shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of DST.

Conditions for International Visits:

- 9. All project related visits to be undertaken by the Scientists from either side in connection with the implementation of the project shall require prior approval from this Department separately on a case to case basis before any expenditure is incurred in this regard.
- 10. As per MoF instructions, it has been decided that in all cases of air travel, both domestic and international, where the Government of India bears the cost of air passage, the officials concerned may

travel only by Air India. For travel to stations not connected by Air India, the officials may travel by Air India to the hub/point closest to their eventual destination, beyond which they may utilize the services of another airline which should also preferable be an alliance partner of Air India.
