During the meeting various issues regarding curriculum modifications as per IQAC recommenda were discussed and resolved as detailed below:

1. Common modifications suggested in Syllabus of M.Sc. Human Genetics and M.Sc. Molecular and M.Sc. Molecu

- a. The courses in the syllabus are re-classified as per the instructions of IQAC, CUPB.
- b. Course codes have been changed as per the instructions from Examination branch of CUPB.
- c. For Biostatistics and Research Methodology, the total credits has been increased from 3 to 4 content in all the four units were modified accordingly and duplications removed.
- d. Introduction to Cell and Molecular Biology is renamed as Cellular and Molecular Biology. course content has also been revised with minor modifications in unit II & III.
- e. Introduction to Cell and Molecular Biology-Practical is renamed as Cellular and Molecular
- f.Human Embryology and Developmental Genetics, Regenerative Medicine and Population Gen and Genetic Epidemiology, Molecular and Cellular Oncology that were earlier part of Elec Course 1 and 2 respectively, are now part of Disciplinary Elective 1 and 2 respectively in Seme
- g. Skill based elective courses (14 Cr.) were kept in Semester-II onwards. These include: C. Seminar-I (1 Cr.), Project Work (4+8 Cr.) and Credit Seminar-II (Presentation Skills; 1 Cr.).
- h. A 4 credit elective MOOC course has been added in Semester-III.
- i. Bioinformatics and Computational Biology has been removed and included in Advanced Prac Course of respective M.Sc. It has been suggested by the experts that MOOC based course Bioinformatics may be recommended to the students.

- II. Unit-I of Techniques in Molecular Medicine has been replaced with Microscopy and unit-III has no been split into unit-II & III.
- III. Part of unit-II is shifted to unit-I in Molecular and Cellular oncology course.
