**Agenda Item No. 1:** To consider the minutes of CDC and approve.

The Minutes of the CDC were approved as presented.

**Agenda Item No. 2:** To consider the reflections added in each unit of all the Courses  
The reflections of few course such as Law and Social Transformation and Applied Legal Studies etc. were not in alignment with others. It was suggested to revise these reflections in synchronization with other courses.

**Agenda Item No. 3:** To review the syllabus of LL.M. and Pre Ph.D. Courses  
To review the contents, content allocation, course credits in the draft syllabus of Ph.D. in Law and LLM programme, Introducing of new IDC, addition of Reflections in each unit of courses as per the recommendations of IQAC (in curriculum audit meeting):

- Graduate attributes were examined, discussed and approved with minor modifications in the draft;
- Proposed allocation of credits in various semesters was approved with the suggestion that a basket of option should contain three subjects from, which the learners should choose one subject. The suggestion was well received and it will be implemented in case of joining of new faculty in Department of Law.
- Minor changes were suggested in Courses of Law and Social Transformation, Judicial Process, Comparative Law and Governance, Applied Legal Studies and title formation of International Humanitarian and Refugee Law;

- Course content of IDC- General Legal Awareness of Law and Civil Defense were examined and changes in content were suggested;
- The draft of course content of newly added course on Clinical Legal Education and Legal Literacy as a practical course and Legalpreneurship as an entrepreneurship course were considered and approved with minor modifications.
- It was resolved that suggested readings in all the courses need to be placed either in alphabetical order or year wise sequence;

**Agenda Item No. 2:**

The Chairperson presented the Panel of Examiners for evaluation of Dissertation of LL.M., Ph.D. (from within the region and outside the region) which was approved unanimously.
