**Agenda 4:** To consider syllabus of MA (Journalism and Mass Communication ) for session 2020-21 with following changes:-


1. Learning outcomes of some courses were rephrased

4. Internship was made compulsory after 3<sup>rd</sup> semester instead of 4<sup>th</sup> semester


**Resolution:** Syllabus was discussed and approved with minor changes including some suggested readings


It was resolved to put the resolutions before the School Board.


**Members also recommended to make field visits/study tours an integral part of the Curriculum.**


Members also resolved to give power to chairperson to make need-based changes in the syllabus.


