In BOS meeting, the following items of agenda were discussed and finalized

Item 1:

To consider post facto approval of the outline of syllabi and courses of reading for 1st semester of M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. Statistics and Ph.D. course work for 2015 batch.
