Subject: Minutes of the 6th Board of Studies (BoS) meeting of the Department of Animal Sciences held on 22nd February, 2019.

The department of Animal Sciences held its 6th BoS meeting on Friday, 22nd February 2019 at 11.00 am in the conference room administrative block, CUPB.

M.Sc. Life Sciences with specialization in Animal Sciences

To review and approve the changes (tabulated amendments made as per the enclosure: Annexure - A) for the M.Sc. program in Life Sciences with specialization in Animal Sciences for the academic session 2019-21. Briefly the changes are in the course codes, updation, deletion, and reshuffle of some of the courses within the framework of IQAC-guidelines to make the masters program coherent and student friendly (*Annexure - I*). In view of the latest guidelines 2018 which is also adopted by the university and as mentioned in CBCS guidelines, the project component is now rephrased and recommended as project/dissertation part I and II of six credits each. ←

In line with university's resolution to rename department of animal sciences as Department of Zoology, the equivalency offered as Zoology to the programme and also in view of the concern of employability of the M.Sc. students, all the BoS members, both external and internal, recommend that the M.Sc. course offered by the Department of Animal Sciences i.e. M.Sc. Life Sciences (Specialization in Animal Sciences) could be renamed as M.Sc. Zoology after necessary approvals from the higher statutory bodies.

Ph.D. in Animal Sciences


The Ph.D. program in Animal Sciences (structure and syllabi) approved via the 5th BoS of the department shall be continued as such without any changes (Annexure - II).





The meeting concluded with a thank note to the external and internal members for their valuable inputs, suggestions and valuable time in strengthening the programs being offered by the department.


