



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN
CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF PUNJAB, BATHINDA
AND
NATIONAL AGRI-FOOD BIOTECHNOLOGY INSTITUTE, MOHALI

PREAMBLE:

The Central University of Punjab, Bathinda (CUPB) and the National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute (NABI), Mohali realise the need for a close linkage between them to further promote the research and academic activities in Punjab region. In harmony with this idea, the CUPB and NABI have expressed a desire to join hands for the cause of promotion of quality research and high end science and decided to sign Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to initiate academic and research programmes between the two Institutions in the broad area of Biological Sciences & Biotechnology as per the following terms and conditions:

1. GENERAL:

- 1.1. CUPB will recognize NABI (DBT) as an accredited Centre for pursuing research, leading to Ph.D. degree of the university in the designated subjects of Biological & Biotechnological Sciences. For the purpose, students eligible for Ph.D. under the Ordinances of the University would be allowed to register for Ph.D. in the respective faculties.
- 1.2. Faculty members of the concerned centers of CUPB and NABI scientists will work towards developing joint research projects in areas of common interest, thereby mutually using the research facilities at CUPB and NABI.
- 1.3. CUPB would recognize and accredit NABI scientists for guiding research leading to Ph.D. degrees of the university. On recommendation of the School Board/Research Degree Committee of CUPB, the Vice Chancellor shall recommend the supervisor of Ph.D. scholars from amongst the CUPB faculty or NABI scientists.
- 1.4. CUPB may confer the status of Adjunct Professor, Adjunct Associate Professor and Adjunct Assistant Professor on NABI scientists, depending upon their qualifications and designations, involved in common programmes with CUPB.
- 1.5. The faculty and students of the concerned centres of CUPB shall be enrolled as ad-hoc members of the library of NABI. While using NABI library facilities, they shall be governed by the rules and regulations as operative at NABI. Scientists and Ph.D. students of NABI shall likewise be given ad-hoc membership of the CUPB library and they shall be governed by the rules and regulations as operative for CUPB library.
- 1.6. The faculty and students of the concerned centers of CUPB shall be issued temporary identity cards by NABI (DBT) and CUPB shall issue temporary identity cards to the scientists of NABI (DBT) as per rules, so as to provide unhindered access to each other's laboratory and other facilities.

1.7. In case of any academic lapses, CUPB will bring the matter to the notice of the Executive Director, NABI for initiating necessary action.

2. ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES:

- 2.1 For the mutual benefit of the two Institutions, there will be exchange of faculty members of the concerned centers of CUPB and NABI scientists.
- 2.2 While registering NABI scientists and research scholars for Ph.D. degree, the ordinances related to Ph.D. of CUPB will be valid including the appointment of Supervisors and Co-supervisors.
- 2.3 CUPB and NABI will work closely to generate appropriately trained manpower in the areas of Biological Sciences & Bio-Technology through organization of formal academic curricula, symposia, short-term training courses, etc.
- 2.4 NABI will provide summer training, research facilities to students (not more than 10 at a time) and NABI scientists will help in the preparation of teaching material for these students.
- 2.5 NABI scientists will assist in the evaluation of students' performance in theory as well as practical classes.
- 2.6 CUPB shall arrange Hostel/Guest House accommodation for scientists and students coming from NABI to CUPB, subject to availability of accommodation. NABI shall arrange Hostel/Guest House accommodation for CUPB faculty and students as and when a Guest House gets constructed, and subject to availability of accommodation.
- 2.7 In the event of patents being filed, out of the research work of a student working at NABI for which no intellectual inputs have been provided by the CUPB teaching faculty, CUPB faculty would not stake any claim to IPRs. However, in the event of a patent being filed, out of a collaborative research work of a student working at NABI for Ph.D. thesis for which CUPB faculty has provided intellectual inputs, the cost of patenting and any monetary benefits accruing subsequent to filing and maintaining the patents will be shared by CUPB and NABI on mutually agreed terms on case to case basis.
- 2.8 In the event of patents being filed, out of the research work of a student working at CUPB for which no intellectual inputs have been provided by NABI scientist (s), NABI would not stake any claim to IPRs. However, in the event of a patent being filed, out of a collaborative research work of a student working at CUPB for Ph.D. thesis for which NABI scientist (s) has provided intellectual inputs, the cost of patenting and any monetary benefit accruing subsequent to filing and maintaining the patents will be shared by the parties on mutually agreed terms on case to case basis.
- 2.9 In the event of a patent being filed out of the collaborative research work between the faculty of CUPB and the scientists of NABI, the cost of patenting and monetary benefits accruing subsequent to filing and maintaining of the patents will be shared by CUPB and NABI on 50:50 basis, respectively.
- 2.10 During Research Degree Committee (RDC) meetings, the supervisors of scholars of CUPB working in NABI shall be invited.

It is agreed that the progress of this MOU shall be monitored by the Review Committee comprising of the Vice Chancellor, CUPB and the Executive Director, NABI or their nominees through periodic meetings.

This MOU is valid for a period of 5 (five) years starting March 28, 2013 subject to further extension on mutually agreed terms and conditions Any mid term change/alteration in the terms and conditions of this MOU as suggested by the Review Committee shall also be deemed to be valid for both the organizations.

The MOU may be terminated if any of the parties wants to withdraw from it. However, the Ph.D. students admitted under the MOU shall be governed by the same terms and conditions as prevailing at the time of signing of the MOU, till the completion of their degrees under the ordinances of CUPB.



M. GENERAL:
