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
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Suggestion/ Recommendations Suggested by the School Board Meeting


Points 1 to 4 applicable for M.A. History

3. To evaluate and provide marks for the M.A. Project instead of the present system of Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory.
4. To hire more faculty members to enable better transaction of course material.
5. No changes suggested for M.A. Political Science, Pre-Ph.D. Coursework of South & Central Asian Studies.
6. The minutes of the meeting put to the School Board Members for their approval:


