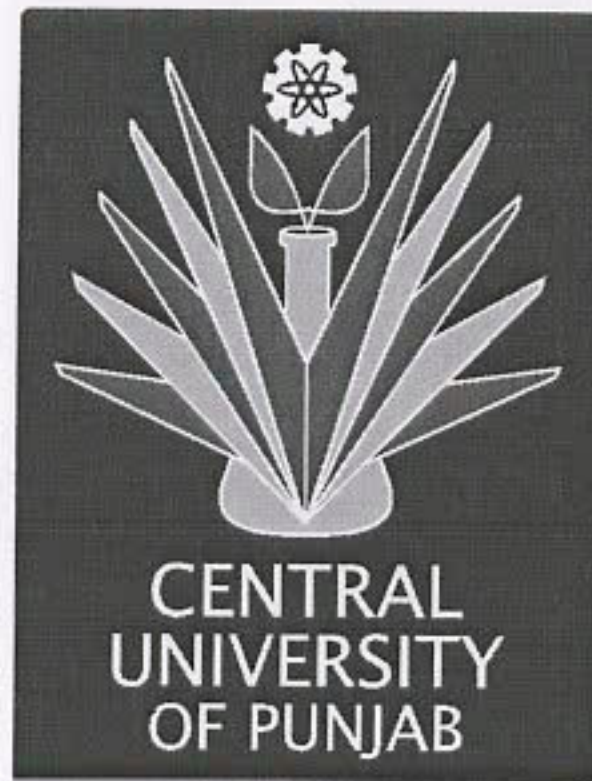

The Secretary apprised the members that, as advised in 11th meeting, the revised progress of Plan expenditure giving an overview of the financial health of the university, covering major heads of expenditure such as buildings, library, equipment, etc. under the budget outlay of the financial year along with investment status, interest earned and statement of fixed deposits are Included in the agenda.

RESOLVE

The Finance Committee Resolved to recommend to the EC the revised progress of Plan Expenditure as per Annexure-12.5 for further approval.

Item:12:2015:5

To consider viable solution for the paucity of space at the City Campus of the university.

The Secretary informed the committee that the item was earlier presented before Finance Committee in its 11th meeting vide Item:11:2015:7, wherein FC advised that the Dean Academic Affairs and Registrar will prepare a full-fledged note with justification indicating number of the students/ faculty members expected to join/leave and accordingly requirement of space.

The committee comprising Dean Academics, Registrar, Executive Engineer, Dean Students Welfare and Chief Warden in its meeting held on 27th November 2015 discussed the issue and made recommendations.

These recommendations were considered by the BAC in its Sub Committee meeting held on 1st December 2015. Accordingly, it was informed that presently 250 boys and 230 girls are residing in respective hostels. In the current session, 140 girls and 153 boys were provided with hostel accommodation. As per the information provided by the wardens approximately 47 girls and 54 boys are likely to vacate the hostels by the end of current session after completing their



academic course. Keeping in view the admission trend for the last year as well as likelihood of introduction of some new courses, the additional demand for hostel accommodation is projected at 130 for girls and 130 for boys. The necessary area marked for the construction and cost estimates were placed under minutes of the Sub Committee of BAC (Annexure-12.6).

RESOLVE

After a detailed discussions, Finance Committee resolved to accept the recommendations of the 21st meeting of Sub Committee of BAC and further resolved to recommend to the EC for consideration/ratification and allow the construction of hostel accommodation for 130 boys and 130 girls of the new admissions in 2016.

Item:12:2015:6

To consider the minutes of the 28th meeting of Building Advisory Committee along with the abstract cost of the building projects, in the prescribed format of UGC, held on 3rd December 2015.

The Secretary presented the recommendations of the 28th meeting of the Building Advisory Committee held on 3rd December 2015 to consider Preliminary Estimate and Building Plans of Phase-IB; Deposit of balance funds to CPWD for left hand side portion of Main Entrance Corridor and Missing Link portion; and Construction of Hostel Accommodation for the session 2016-17 at City Campus (Annexure-12.7).

The Secretary further presented the comments of Sh. Fazal Mahmood, Deputy Secretary (Finance), MHRD that *no specific comments are made except that the Civil works/ projects should be finalised only after a detailed re-prioritization exercise of the proposed projects has been carried out and only those projects should be approved which are fully funded and are strictly within the sanctioned budget grant of the university for the year 2015-16/XII Plan.*

It was found that the recommendations of the BAC already took care of the availability of funds and re-prioritized the construction accordingly.

RESOLVE

After having discussions, Finance Committee resolved to ratify the recommendations of the 28th meeting of BAC keeping in view the suggestions of the Dy. Secretary Finance and further resolved to allow the construction of Phase-IB to include the following



buildings, depending on the funds allocated by UGC:

- a. VC Residence
- b. Transit Hostel
- c. UG Hostel (Men)
- d. UG Hostel (Girls)
- e. Site Development - Partial as per need
- f. VC Office Subject to availability of funds

The agenda items have been perused and the following comments are made:

Item No. 11:2015:1C - To confirm the minutes of Tenth Meeting of Finance Committee held on 7th September, 2015 (**page 1-3 of Agenda papers**).

Comments: Our comments earlier sent to you vide E-Mail dated 19.10.2015 are re-iterated. Further, it is emphasised that the instructions contained in the O.M. No. 7(1)/E.Coord./2014 dated 29.10.2014, issued by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, relating to "Expenditure Management - Economy Measure and Rationalisation of Expenditure", which, inter-alia, also regulate purchase of vehicles, are emphatic in nature and need to be strictly followed by the University and these instructions are not open for interpretations in any other manner.

Accordingly, the following lines (on page 3 of Agenda papers) need to be deleted and the text of the Agenda Item 11:2015:1C, to that extent, needs to be suitably revised :

" Such instructions were issued in the financial years 2011-12,2012-13,2013-14, 2014-15 and remained in force in the relevant financial years only. Had the instructions.....As on date, no such orders / instructions are issued for financial year 2015 - 16. "





Quality of concrete of ongoing phase-1A works:

The Executive Engineer, CUPB with due permission of the chair submitted that the quality of concrete is continuously a cause for concern. The contractor submitted a mix design of M-30 concrete in foundation from IIT Kanpur with cement content of 500 kg/cm (PPC). This much cement content is more than codal provisions of 450kg/cum more. The provision in estimate is for 330 kg/cm. thus extra payment for 170 kg/cm is to be made at the same time concrete cubes are not giving proportionate 7 days strength. The quality of cement is not being assured by IIT Kanpur. The strength of concrete is not being attained. The EIL is working with wait and watch policy. The contractor is doing work at very slow pace.
