The committee discussed the syllabi, course structure, budget for field work and dissertation mark in geology and geography and put forward the following suggestion;

1. Changes are made on M.Sc. Geology where new papers are introduced into the syllabus.
2. Practical hours in M.Sc. Geology programme the practical hours should be of 4 hours.
3. Changes are also made on Ph.D. Geology on the part of paleontology in view of UGC guidelines.
4. Suggestion were made on numbers of optional paper. Optional paper should be limited in regards to the number of faculty strength.
5. Natural history museum should be created in the university.
6. Field work should be conducted for one to two days field trip per month and be made on weekends.
7. Geological film could be shown which could be included in the syllabus in tutorial classes.
8. MA/MSc Geography syllabus was discussed. Social & demography geography, Watershed management, Geography of forest are introduced.
9. Field visit and Survey are combined with having 2 credits.
10. In M.Sc. Geography programme student have to opt for compulsory and interdisciplinary course on soil pollution and management theory as well as practical, so the IDC course is removed

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
11. Dissertation credit were discussed and credit remain the same as 10 credits. But there will be no marks for dissertation/project work

Suggestions given by all the experts and members are incorporated and syllabi is modified and updated.


The member of the Board of Studies for Centre for Geography and Geology discussed the agenda and unanimously resolved the following;

6. The committee unanimously resolved and recommended separate budget for the field work for Geography and Geology PG Programmes.


