Agenda 1: To review and approve the syllabus of M.Sc. Geology programme for academic session 2022-24 onwards.

Suggestions from the External experts/Committee members:

- External experts recommended to bring the course EGS 556 Solid Earth Geophysics of third semester to prior semester
- External experts recommended to include exercises on data mining from Groundwater Estimation and Management System (GEMS) portal of Central Ground Water Board, India.
- Committee recommended to add option of internship/industrial training along with M.Sc. Dissertation

Resolve:

- The committee resolved to exchange the courses EGS 530 (Geological Time and Stratigraphy) of second semester with the course EGS 556 (Solid Earth Geophysics) of third semester. This shifting will not affect the total credit of the respective semester and distribution of the course.
- The members resolved to include exercises on data mining from Groundwater Estimation and Management System (GEMS) portal of Central Ground Water Board, India in the course EGS-517.
- The members resolved to modify the title of the course EGS 600 Dissertation Part-1 and EGS 600 Dissertation Part-2 as Dissertation Part-1/Short-term internship/Industrial training of Third semester, which shall be linked to the Dissertation Part-2/Internship/Industrial Trailing of Fourth Semester.
- The committee unanimously resolved to adopt the recommended course structure, detailed syllabus content for the semesters I, II, III and IV of M.Sc. Geology for 2022-24 and onwards (Annexure I) with the above modifications. [Total credit for the program and course structure is aligned with university guidelines towards successful implementation of NEP, 2020. The updates and reorganization of the curriculum compare to the previous year is enclosed as Annexure II.]
