Subject: Regarding XIIIth meeting of Curriculum Design and Development Committee.

XIIIth meeting of Curriculum Design and Development Committee (CDDC) of the Centre was held on 06th February, 2020 and following points were discussed:

Agenda 1: To review and recommend the syllabi of M. Pharm., M.Sc. and Ph.D. programs.

Resolution: The committee reviewed and recommended the syllabi for putting it in the forthcoming Board of Studies meeting for further recommendations and approval.

Agenda 2: Regarding inclusion of MOOC course in M. Pharm. and M.Sc.

Resolution: The committee recommended that students may opt for two Inter Disciplinary Courses of 02 credits each or one MOOC course of 04 credits in first two semesters in M. Pharm and M.Sc. (In principle approved by Competent Authority). Further, the faculty of the Department will offer an Inter disciplinary Course of 02 credits in future when there will be an adequate number of faculty. Since, at present we are only 05 faculty members teaching three PG programs. Further, students are suggested to opt any of the following MOOC course of 04 Credits from list of MOOCs Course for SWAYAM, as approved in 34th Meeting of Executive Council of the University:


- Analytical Techniques (S. No. 2 of the approved PG MOOC Courses list)
- Organic Chemistry – 1 (S. No. 31 of the approved PG MOOC Courses list)
- Research Ethics (S. No. 33 of the approved PG MOOC Courses list)
- Solid and Hazardous Waste Management (S. No. 38 of the approved PG MOOC Courses list)

Agenda 3: Regarding adoption of PCI evaluation system in toto to comply it with PCI regulations for syllabi.

Resolution: The committee recommended adoption of PCI evaluation system in toto w.e.f. session 2020-21 onwards in case of M. Pharm. courses as we have already adopted PCI syllabi for M. Pharm. courses.


Agenda 4: Regarding inclusion of a course on "Research and Publication Ethics" in pre-Ph.D. registration course work

Resolution: The committee recommended the inclusion of a course on "Research and Publication Ethics" (30 hours) in pre-Ph.D. registration course work from session 2020-21 onwards as per directions of UGC. The course contains two sections i.e. Theory and Practice of 15 hours each. Since Theory portion deals with general aspects of Philosophy and Ethics, Scientific Conduct and Publication Ethics which are common to students of all Science disciplines, hence may be taught jointly at University level. However, Practice section is discipline specific and should be taught at respective Department level.
