In the 2nd semester GEO.538 Resource and Economic Activities is renamed as GEO.538 Economic Geography. In the 3rd semester GEO.567 Social, Cultural and Political Geography is separated into two new courses as GEO.567 Social and Cultural Geography and GEO.573 Political Geography. Similarly, GEO.568 Transport Geography and Regional Development (GEO.568) is also separated into GEO.568 Regional Development and Planning and GEO.572 Spatial and Transportation Planning. GEO.523 Geographical thoughts is renamed as GEO.523 Geographic Thoughts. Accordingly, the title of the courses and its related structure and syllabus has been modified and attached detailed in annexure 1.
