Resolution: The committee recommended below mentioned guidelines regarding the training/internship of 3rd/4th PG students to put in the forthcoming BoS/School Board meetings:


- Students may be allowed for short or full semester training/internship in industry only with consent from supervisor and approval from competent authority.


Agenda 5: To revise the eligibility criteria in the Department of Pharmacology for admission to PhD Programme as follows:




Resolution: The committee discussed and recommended the proposed eligibility criteria in the Department of Pharmacology for admission to PhD Programme as follows:




