To note the compliance of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court w.r.t. appointment of Mr. Ajit Paul Singh as Senior Technical Assistant (Laboratory).

#### **AGENDA NOTE**

It is brought to the information of the august members of the Executive Council that Mr. Ajit Paul Singh, already working as Senior Technical Assistant (Laboratory) on contractual basis, had filed a CWP No 176 of 2024 in 2017 in Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court at Chandigarh.

The Hon'ble High Court has issued an order on dated 15.05.2025, wherein it is directed that:

"The respondents are directed to issue the benefit of appointment to the petitioner on regular basis forthwith and without any delay. The benefits shall be calculated notionally w.e.f. the date of initial appointment while the actual benefits of regular appointment/grade pay shall be released to the petitioner within a period of one month of receipt of certified copy of this order." (copy attached as **Annexure-62.2.** 

The University sought a legal opinion on the said order from the concerned Senior Panel Counsel vide letter dated 28.5.2025. In view of the said legal opinion and in compliance of the orders of the Hon'ble Court, Mr. Ajit Paul Singh has been issued an Offer of Appointment to the post of Senior Technical Assistant (Laboratory) on regular basis with the terms that the benefits shall be calculated notionally w.e.f. the date of initial appointment while the actual benefits of regular appointment/grade pay shall be released to the petitioner within a period of one month of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The Executive Council is requested to note the action of University in compliance to the orders of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Further, as authorised by the Executive Council, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has accepted the legal opinion and approved the recommendations of the Committee subject to the ratification of the Executive Council. Accordingly, the University has issued Office Order No. CUPB/Estt./2024/PF/ 221 dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure-62.6) regarding the earlier Office Order withdrawal of No. CUPB/CC/Estt./2020/PF/1322 dated 14.08.2020 and to initiate the process for placement from Pay Level – 12 to Pay Level – 13 afresh in respect of Ms. Shweta Arora, Ex-Deputy Registrar, Central University of Punjab.

#### Item.No:EC:62:2025:21

То consider the recommendation of the Building Committee meeting held 13.05.2025 (Item:BC:60: 2025:9) regarding status of works entrusted (India) to M/s NBCC Limited **PMC** for as construction of new buildings under Phase 2A.

#### **AGENDA NOTE**

The conceptual plans of all the 05 buildings were submitted by the NBCC (India) Limited and the same was reviewed and the observations were given to NBCC and the revised plans submitted NBCC were considered and approved by the Project Monitoring Committee in its 27<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 07.04.2025.

Subsequently, after the approval of conceptual plans, M/s NBCC (India) Limited has submitted the Preliminary Estimates vide letter no.: NBCC/SBG-HP/2025/174 dated 03.05.2025 for amounting to Rs.228.61 Crores including PMC fee & taxes. The Engineering office reviewed the Preliminary estimates and suggested some amendments to NBCC (India) Limited vide email dated 07.05.2025.

M/s NBCC had submitted the revised estimates amounting to Rs. 2,29,07,80,667.86/- including PMC fee & taxes (Annexure-62.10). The revised estimates submitted by NBCC are hereby placed before the Building Committee for consideration and approval. After the approval, A/A and E/S will be communicated to M/s NBCC (India) limited for the preparation of DBR and calling the tender as per guidelines.

#### **Discussions during the BC meeting:**

The Committee discussed in detail, the revised estimates amounting to Rs.2,29,07,80,667.86/- including PMC fee & taxes as submitted by the NBCC (India) limited. CGM, NBCC informed that the estimates include the cost of building, furnishing, CCTV, IPBAX, UPS, DG set, Roof top solar in Academic Building and water heating system in hostels. It also includes the furniture in buildings except international student



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hostel. He also informed that STP of required quantity was also included in the estimates which was not the part of 201 cr proposal but it is required for proper functionality of these buildings.

Thereafter, CGM NBCC suggested that as university is making proposal for new buildings, one combined STP be built to meet the consolidated requirement of these 5 buildings and new buildings. The committee discussed the proposal and deliberated that constructing one combined STP instead of two small STP's will reduce the operational & maintenance cost. Therefore, the committee directed the NBCC to submit the revised cost for these five buildings without considering STP. NBCC informed that the revised estimated cost (w/o STP) was ₹2,26,48,25,709/- and also submitted the same vide their email dated 13.05.2025.

During the meeting, the committee also inquired for the Estimated Tendered Cost & tentative Completion cost of the project. CGM NBCC informed that Estimated Tendered Cost will be Rs. 193.13 Cr. and the estimated completion cost will be within the sanctioned cost of Rs 200.99 Cr which will depend upon the response of the tender. The tentative break-up of the cost is enclosed as Annexure 60.9.1.

Further, he also informed that after the approval of Estimates by the University NBCC will submit the Design Basis Report which will include the complete details of the design, other provisions and the finishing schedule of the work. After the approval of DBR the tender will be floated by NBCC.

The Building Committee after detailed discussions, unanimously resolved to approve the following:

- 1. Considering the Estimated Tendered Cost of Rs. 193.13 Cr and completion cost of Rs 200.32 Cr. The Committee approved the revised estimates of Rs. 2,26,48,25,709/-.
- The cost of the STP & other external services to be included in new proposals being taken up by the University.
- 3. After tendering process is completed, NBCC to submit the tentative cost of completion. If the cost increases from the sanctioned cost, then University may approach to HEFA/MOE for approval of revised cost of the project.

The resolution of the Building Committee is placed is before the Council for consideration.

To consider the request of faculty members regarding credit of Earned Leaves in lieu of online teaching during vacations for Academic Year-2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22.

Some of the faculty members had submitted their request to give them Earned Leaves in lieu of the online teaching work rendered by them during the vacations i.e. (Winter & Summer) for Academic Year-2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22. However, these vacations were announced/notified by the University as per the following details:

- Clause No. 8.3(III) (i) of the UGC Regulations, 2018 (page no. 91) is reproduced below:-
  - (i) Earned leave admissible to a teacher shall be:
    - (a) 1/30th of actual service including vacation; plus
    - (b) 1/3rd of the period, if any, during which he/she is required to perform duty during vacation.

For purposes of computation of period of actual service, all periods of leave except casual, special casual and duty leave shall be excluded.

2. The recommendations of the Standing Committee in its meeting held on 15.11.2022 are reproduced below (Annexure-62.13):-



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"..... The matter was discussed at length and the Standing Committee recommends that all the faculty members are entitled for credit of Earned Leave to their leave account as per the UGC Regulations, 2018 since they have performed the teaching duties (online) during the vacations in response to different notifications/office orders of the University issued from time to time. The Committee further recommends that the Earned Leave may also be credited to the leave account of all the faculty members for the Non-declaration of winter vacations (02 weeks) during Academic Year-2020-21 and curtailment of Summer Vacation (01 week) during Academic Year 2021-22."

Accordingly, details of period for which EL may be credited in the leave account of all faculty members as per the UGC Regulations, 2018, are as under:

The recommendations of the Committee were placed before the Executive Council in its special meeting held on 28.12.2022 vide **Item No. EC: SM:Dec:2022:6.** The resolve of the EC is as under:- (Annexure-62.14)

"In order to avoid any audit para, a clarification be obtained from the UGC, MoE, CAG especially where the vacations was allowed along with online teaching."

Accordingly, the University vide letter No. CUPB/Estt./2023/EL/37 dated 24.01.2023, CUPB/Estt./2023/EL/38 dated 24.01.2023 and CUPB/Estt./2023/EL/39 dated 24.01.2023 approached to the MoE, UGC and CAG respectively for seeking clarification on the above said matter.

In response to abovesaid letters, the University has received response from the CAG vide letter No DGA/Vetting-II/2022-23/290 dated 06.03.2023 and from UGC vide email dated 04.12.2023. However, no response has been received from the MoE.

The comments received from the CAG and UGC are as under:

On receipt of above clarifications, the matter was referred back to the Standing Committee for deliberation & recommendations.

In the light of resolve of the EC and clarifications received from the UGC & CAG, the Standing Committee in its meeting held on 22.12.2023 & 19.01.2024 reaffirmed the earlier recommendations of this committee mentioned in Para No. 4 above. The committee further proposed to place the matter in the Executive Council for consideration. (Minutes of the meeting held on 22.12.2023 & 19.01.2024 are attached at Annexure-62.17).

The matter was placed before the Executive Council in its 51<sup>st</sup> meeting vide item No. EC:51:2024:31. The Executive Council has resolved as under:- (Annexure-62.18)

"The information on this issue be obtained from the other Central Universities and a fresh agenda be brought to the next meeting of the Council for consideration."

The matter was placed before the Executive Council in its 56<sup>th</sup> meeting vide item No. EC:56:24:12. The Executive Council has resolved as under:- (Annexure-62.21)

> "A clarification on the matter again be obtained from UGC."

Further, in compliance to the resolve of 56<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Executive Council, the University has again sent letter No. CUPB/Estt./2025/EL/154 dated 29.01.2025 followed by reminder letter No. CUPB/Estt./2025/EL/326 04.04.2025 to the UGC for seeking clarification w.r.t credit of Earned Leave into the leave account of the faculty members of this University in lieu of online teaching during vacations for Academic Year-2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22. (Attached at *Annexure- 62.22*). However, no response has been received from UGC till date.

It is further submitted that due to non-settling of this matter, the University is not able to credit the Earned Leave in the leave account of faculty members since Year 2020. The leave encashment of many ex-faculty members have also not been settled due to this.

The matter is placed is before the Council for consideration.

#### **RESOLVE**

The Council unanimously resolved that since the grant of Earned Leaves to the faculty members in lieu of online teaching during vacations for Academic Year-2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, involves the undue financial liability on the University and may invite audit paras, therefore, no Earned Leaves be granted to the faculty members in lieu of online teaching during vacations for Academic Year-2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22.

However, to compensate, the Council unanimously resolved that "vacation-for-vacation" be granted and a Committee be constituted to draw the modalities in this regard.

#### To consider and approve the recommendations of Academic Council regarding draft ordinance of Statute-40, Schools of Studies' of the University.

#### **AGENDA NOTE:**

Initially, the approval of the Hon'ble Visitor regarding Schools of Studies and Centres was received vide letter no. F.No.42-26/2009-Desk(U) dated 16<sup>th</sup> March 2011 from the Ministry of Human Resource Development. 12 Schools of Studies and 68 Centres of Studies assigned under it were approved through above letter.

Later, the Ordinance-I (Schools & Centres of Studies) was sent to the MHRD/UGC for approval in 2012, the MHRD/UGC replied in 2013 that 'as regard to Ordinance No. I,



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university may include School of Studies in Statutes instead of Ordinance-I. Centre can be included in Ordinance.'

Further, UGC vide letter No. F.No.15-5/2012(CU) dated 11.10.2013 sanctioned establishment of School of Education with seven teaching positions.

Thus, we have 13 Schools of Studies and nomenclatures of these Schools of Studies have been changed during the last five years. Recently, the Executive Council in its 38<sup>th</sup> meeting vide item No. EC:38:2021:5 resolved new nomenclatures for these 13 Schools of Studies, which are listed below:

- School of Basic Sciences
- 2. School of Biological Sciences
- School of Health Sciences
- 4. School of Pharmaceutical Sciences
- 5. School of Engineering and Technology
- 6. School of Environment and Earth Sciences
- 7. School of Social Sciences
- 8. School of Management
- 9. School of Language, Literature and Culture
- 10. School of International Studies
- 11. School of Legal Studies
- 12. School of Education
- 13. School of Information and Communication Studies

A Committee was constituted by the Competent Authority to review/prepare the Ordinances/Statutes vide No. CUPB/24/ Ordinance/242 dated 05.01.2024. The duly constituted committee held its meeting on 12—14 April 2024 at CUPB.

The Committee recommended the draft of the Statute 40 of Schools of Studies. Minutes of the meeting of this committee including the draft Statute is placed at **Annexure-62.23** 

The item was placed in the Academic Council, through circulation vide <u>Item.No:AC:TC:Mar:25:15</u> for consideration, the following was resolved:
