To consider the amendment in the Cadre Recruitment Rules 2021 of Central University of Punjab as follows:

- A. the amendments in the Cadre Recruitment Rules related to Upper Age Limit and Age Relaxation**
B. the amendments in the Cadre Recruitment Rules related to Driver (Ordinary Grade, Grade-II & Grade-I)

NOTE:

- a. The UGC vide Letter No. F.No.7-1/2022/JCRC dated 27.09.2022 has circulated Model Cadre Recruitment Rules (CRRs) including the complete details of upper age, qualifications, experience etc. for almost all the posts sanctioned to Central University of Punjab, Bathinda (CUPB) **Annexure-2**

Though the CUPB has already notified its Cadre Recruitment Rules (CRRs) for recruitment to the non-teaching and other academic staff of the university, the upper age limit for some of the posts given below has been mentioned less than the given model cadre recruitment rules:

It is pertinent to mention that due to the COVID-19 pandemic and a long time taken in approval for the Cadre Recruitment Rules of the University, the University could not advertise the non-teaching posts in the years 2020-2021 and resultantly many of the young jobs seekers including the internal employees of the university have become overaged for applying to some of the above posts.

It is also pertinent to mention Para 4 of the said letter of UGC, which is reproduced below:

“The Model Cadre Recruitment Rules as approved by the Commission are attached herewith for taking appropriate action, wherever the CRRs approved by their competent authority are not available. The Universities having CRRs approved by the competent authority, may continue with the recruitment processes for non-teaching positions as per their approved CRRs.”



Further, a request has been received from a Widow candidate Smt. Suniti, who requested to allow the age relaxation for applying for the Group-A, B & C posts as per the Govt. of India Rules. When gone through her representation and the GOI Rules for age relaxation, we found that there is a provision in the GOI Rules (**Annexure-13**) for age relaxation to Widows, Divorced Women and Women judicially separated from their husbands and who are not married. However, the CUPB CRRs are silent on age relaxation to such category. Therefore, it is required to amend the relevant clause of the CRRs.

In view of the above, existing CRRs of the CUPB need to be amended as per detail given below:

Clause No. 8.3(III) (i) of the UGC Regulations, 2018 (page no. 91) is reproduced below:-

 - (b) *1/3rd of the period, if any, during which he/she is required to perform duty during vacation.*

For purposes of computation of period of actual service, all periods of leave except casual, special casual and duty leave shall be excluded.

The matter was placed before the Standing Committee to look into the matter in its meeting held on 15.11.2022.

It is stated that the Executive Council vide Item:No:EC:35:2019:42 approved the recommendations of the Committee which recommended that promotion under CAS may be granted proceeding day of their confirmation to their substantive post subject to fulfilment of other eligibility criteria as laid down under UGC Regulation. As per the above resolve of the Executive Council, promotion under CAS were recommended **w.e.f. from proceeding day of confirmation to substantive post with prospective effect.**

Further, the University has now notified the "CUP Faculty Members (Counting of Past Service Guidelines, 2021) vide notification No. 050 dated 26/05/2022 as approved by the Executive Council in its 39th meeting vide Item No. EC:39:2022:49.

As per the clause 4.8 of said guidelines states that If a faculty member of the university has an evidence of a past service of 4/5/6 (as the case may be) or more years being rendered under these guidelines, then a maximum of 4 years for Assistant Professor at the entry level, and a maximum of 3 years for Associate Professor of such services upto the date of joining at CUP, shall be counted for promotion under CAS to the next level from the date of eligibility of the candidate for such promotion.

(i) Provided that counting of past services shall be settled in accordance with the UGC Regulations as applicable to the candidate on her/his date of joining at CUP for settlement of promotion under CAS as per the relevant UGC Regulation(s) applicable to the applicant on her/his date of eligibility for such promotion.

(ii) However, benefits of promotion under CAS shall be admissible, in lieu of her/his past services being counted at CUP, from the date of her/his joining at CUP or thereafter, as the case may be, after successful completion of the probation and



confirmation thereof.

After taking the clause 8.4 (ii) of CUP Faculty Members (Counting of Past Service Guidelines, 2021), the promotions under CAS are to be granted from the date of her/his joining at CUP or thereafter, as the case may be, after successful completion of the probation and confirmation thereof, subject to fulfillment of other requirement.

In view of above, the following faculty who were already promoted from Academic Pay Level-10 to Academic Pay Level-11 w.e.f. proceeding day of confirmation to substantive post with prospective effect instead of their date of eligibility have requested to review/reconsider the date of promotion:
