



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF PUNJAB
AND
CENTRAL INSTITUTE OF INDIAN LANGUAGES



1. **The Central University of Punjab, Ghudda (Bathinda)** hereinafter referred to as "CUP" was established through the Central Universities Act 2009 which received the assent of the President of India on 20th March 2009. The University is accredited with 'A' grade from NAAC. The Central University of Punjab is the youngest university that has secured its position in the top 100 institutions (84th Rank) in the University category & 1st amongst New Central Universities in the MHRD's NIRF Ranking 2021. The university has a mission of providing a wide range of instructional and research facilities across integrated and cross-disciplines, and to promote innovation in teaching, learning and research.
2. **Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore** is a premier institute of languages which was established to coordinate the development of Indian languages, to bring about the essential unity of Indian languages through scientific studies, to promote inter-disciplinary research, to contribute to mutual enrichment of languages, and thus to contribute towards emotional integration of the people of India. It advises and assists Central as well as State Governments in the matters of language. CIIL has seven regional centres which impart instruction in 20 Indian languages.

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) is entered into on this day of _____

BETWEEN

The Central University of Punjab (CUP) being represented by its Registrar, having its office at village Ghudda, District Bathinda, Punjab in India hereinafter referred to as the PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.

AND

Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore being represented by its Director, having its office at Mysore, Karnataka in India hereinafter referred to as the PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.

WITNESSETH that

WHEREAS, the Party of the First Part is an educational institution, established by the Government of India vide an act of Parliament, and engaged in advancement of teaching and research in several branches of humanities, social sciences, science and languages. Reassuring its resolve and commitment and social responsibilities, towards

achieving the educational needs of the area, adopted the Party of the Second part to help its constituents for the advancement of knowledge and creativity.

Whereas the Party of the 2nd part is a premier Institution of Ministry of Education, Government of India established to coordinate the development of Indian languages by assisting the Government of India and State Governments in language-related matters and by conducting workshops, training programs, publication of books and monographs, conducting research, organizing conferences and seminars etc.

WHEREAS both, Party of First Part and the Party of the Second Part with complimentary tasks have come to an understanding to promote cooperation between the two organizations in the field of education, research and development.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. This MoU is valid for a period of three years, to promote Research and Innovation, which can be extendable.
2. Both the parties will promote cooperation between the two organizations in the field of education, innovation and research on Indian languages.
3. Both the parties will work together to enhance the academic interchange between the two institutions to promote teaching and research.
4. The teachers, staff and students of the institutions will have the liberty to use the facilities – Laboratory equipment, library, playground, gymnasium, auditorium etc. of the other party, if available, as per rules in force.
5. The students and faculty of the first party under this MoU can use the CIIL library and the studio facilities for this purpose, as per rules in force.
6. The faculty of party of the first part can attend the seminars of the party of the second part without any fee.
7. Both the parties can mutually invite faculty & research scholars to their Institutions for academic talks and interactions, for collaborative research, and for guidance as per the need and availability.
8. Faculty of both the parties can apply for research funding for collaborative research projects on mutually agreeable basis.
9. The party of the First Part may allocate its students for research guidance and internships to the party of the Second Part. In all such mutually agreed instances, the faculty from First Party shall be the supervisor / guide while the faculty members from Second Party shall act as co-supervisor/co-guide. In all such instances, the library, studio and laboratory facilities of the Second Party may be extended for academic use by the bonafide students of the First Party on mutually agreed terms.

10. The Parties of the First Part and Second Part will obtain all internal approvals, consents, permission, and licenses of whatsoever nature required on different occasions on the terms specified herein.
11. There will not be any financial liability on either party.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The MoU shall be deemed to have been automatically rescinded after the expiry of the MoU period, unless renewed for further period as per mutually agreed upon terms at a later stage. It is further agreed that following the termination of the MoU, both the parties shall refrain from carrying out the balance of the activities agreed upon in this MoU.
2. Either of the parties hitherto shall be entitled to terminate the MoU at any time with valid reasons acceptable in writing to both parties and in such case, the MoU will be terminated six months after the date of written notification or date of expiry of the MoU, whichever is earlier. In case of such premature termination of the MoU, all rights and obligations of both parties shall automatically cease except for those covered by written contracts including ongoing collaborative activity that can no longer be cancelled.
3. In case of any dispute that may crop up during execution of the MoU, the matter would be settled through arbitration by referring to a committee jointly appointed by both the parties.
